(Background info FYI)

During the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Festival, the population of Auburn Indiana grows from a mere 12,000 to well over 100,000 with visitors filling nearby hotels and motels to capacity.

The excitement in Auburn begins in early August as the appearance of vintage classic automobiles from yesteryear begin to fill the streets. As visitors begin to arrive with their classic show-cars, the entire town takes on the glow of an old time movie production.

While the festival actively pursues these endeavors year-round, Labor Day weekend is at the heart of the celebration. In 2018, we will celebrate the 63rd annual Auburn-Cord-Duesenberg Festival. The events of the weekend actually start the weekend prior to Labor Day and run for the full week concluding on Labor Day every year.

More than 1.5 million people travel through DeKalb County each year for auctions, museums and other attractions. It is estimated that \$75 million is generated directly or indirectly by visitors, causing many local businesses to say that Labor Day serves as their thirteenth month.

The culmination of a year's planning occurs in the week before Labor Day weekend with the annual Auburn Cord Duesenberg Festival.
